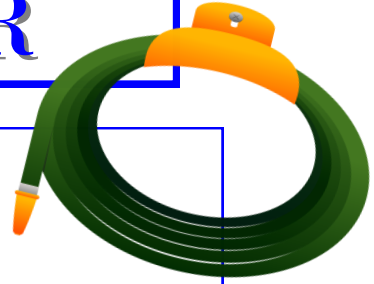


WATER REMINDER



Did you know.....

About 95% of the water entering our homes goes down the drain.

A garden hose or sprinkler can use almost as much water in an hour as an average family of four uses in one day.

People now use 127 percent more water than we did in 1950.

You may not receive a bill for water but you do pay for this in your monthly assessment. In order to keep from having assessments go up every year due to extra costs for things that can be prevented check your faucets and toilets for leaks. If you have a hose make sure you are not over watering and causing run-off.

If utility bills are increased each year this impacts the associations budget and determining the monthly assessments each year. Please do your part as a homeowner and help by using less water when applicable.
